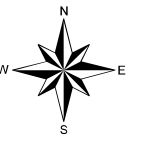
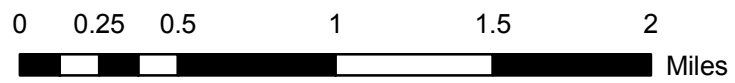


**Hazards Map - Orange, NH**
