

- focus on stormwater runoff (surface water and ground water)
- acknowledging that there is scant information about existing septic systems, identify them and then quantify effects
- facilitate communication among towns so they can benefit from each other's work
- support enforcement of state and local ordinances (perhaps on shared town basis)
- do more education for town officials and the general public
- continue to focus on recycling
- continue to focus on energy
- build-out analysis was extraordinarily helpful - update
- share best practices within the watershed and across the region
- continue hazardous waste collection
- expand affordable housing
- seek better coordination on work on infrastructure, esp bridges and roads
- do a link for UVLSRPC on town websites
- outreach to towns as to how to keep town regulations more in keeping with each other across the region
- look at small, medium, and large towns when bringing forward and sharing best practices

After the meeting people asked that we send notes to town websites about all of the five sessions; they also asked that we bring out drafts of the strategic plan to these sub-regions.

There was also discussion that mandated RPC's are an unfunded mandate and that they should be better funded.
