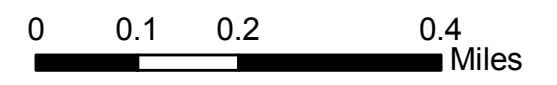
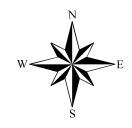


Map 2. Hazard Areas and Critical Facilities Newport, NH - Downtown Area (see Map 1 for Town-wide Map)
