SHREDDED PAPER (Non-glossy, non-color)

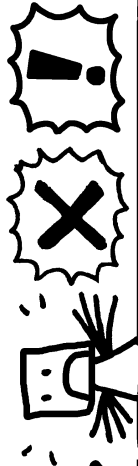


SHREDDED CARDBOARD (No wax, tape, glue)
