1. Call to Order

Mr. Jones called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

2. Action on Minutes from May 2, 2017

3. State Clean Diesel Project Solicitation - NH DES

Ms. Strachen from New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services presented the attached presentation about the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act and programs for the State. NH DES will be accepting applications between 10/1 and 10/15.

4. Public Involvement Plan

Ms. Butts explained the requirements for the UVLSRPC Public Involvement Plan required by NH Department of Transportation. The Committee reviewed the document. Mr. Sweet moved to adopt the plan. Mr. Edkins seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

5. Other Business

a. TAC Member Updates

Mr. Schneider and Ms. Butts discussed the September 21 Governor's Advisory Commission on Intermodal Transportation (GACIT) Hearing in Lebanon at City Hall. Drafts of the Ten Year Plan (TYP) are located on the NHDOT website. Mr.

Edkins, explained that there is some confusion of a Charlestown project that is listed twice in the draft with different amounts and project numbers. Mr. Edkins will reach out to NHDOT. There has been no real change in the region in the TYP. Mr. Schneider stressed the importance of the Committee and community members attended the GACIT hearing to support funded for the TYP. Doing everything they can to make sure that the TYP is funded. Mr. Schneider spoke of the first GACIT hearing of the year regarding changes in the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality grant funding program. Regional Planning Commissions will no longer be involved in the project scoring process. Mr. Schneider stressed the importance of CMAQ projects being distributed throughout the State as best they can. Ms. Heverly spoke of Vital Communities' Upper Valley Transportation Management Association (UVTMA) next meeting will be to attend the GACIT hearing in support of transportation funding in our region. Ms. Heverly welcomed all TAC members to join the UVTMA at this special meeting at the GACIT hearing.
